Taiwan's unique climate and geography nurture a wide variety of teas-from fresh and delicate green tea, to complex oolong tea, to rich and mellow black tea. Among them, oolong tea is the most representative.

Across different regions, each tea carries its own character: Wenshan Bozhong (North) - light and refined, Alishan & Lishan High mountain tea (Central) - smooth and mellow, Dang Ding Oolong (Nantou) - roasted and warm, Oriental Beauty (Hsinchu, Miaoli) & Sun Moon Lake black tea - richly layered and aromatic.

Sip slowly, breathe deeply, and you'll discover... Every cup of tea reflects Taiwan's land and culture.

Tea Experience

In Taiwan, tea is more than a drink; it's a journey you can participate in.

Beyond stepping into tea gardens to experience manual harvesting, stir-frying, and the traditional tea-making process, visitors can also participate in formal tea ceremonies, tea sealing, tea whisking, tea dyeing, and specialized tea tasting sessions. For those seeking a deeper connection, guided mini-tours with professional tea masters offer profound insights into the heritage of tea culture.

Through hands-on experiences, engage all five senses and create unforgettable memories in Taiwan's tea villages.

Tea Cuisine

"In Taiwan, tea is more than just a beverage; it is artfully integrated into cuisine, giving rise to a unique culture where 'tea meets table.'"

Many restaurants and rural eateries use tea leaves as a key ingredient, utilizing their delicate fragrance and lingering sweetness (hou-gan) to elevate the complexity of a dish. Iconic examples include tea eggs, tea oil chicken, tea-braised pork, and tea-smoked chicken. Tea also shines in desserts like tea jelly, tea ice cream, and tea cakes, allowing people to experience the versatile flavor profiles of Taiwanese tea in diverse ways.

Rural restaurants and "Tian Mama" (Mother Tian's) culinary groups across the island often design creative tea-themed menus using local leaves and seasonal ingredients to present the most authentic countryside flavors. Remarkably, in 2025, a tea estate even earned a recommendation in the "MICHELIN Guide."

Tea Souvenirs

When visiting Taiwan's tea regions, buying premium tea, savoring fine brews, and participating in DIY tea-making are essential experiences-but bringing home a unique souvenir is the true hallmark of a travel connoisseur.

Taiwanese tea is often characterized by limited production and organic cultivation. Every leaf carries the meticulous care of the farmers and the essence of nature, making it nearly impossible to find an identical tea anywhere else. To complement this exclusivity, many tea gardens and estates have carefully developed signature souvenirs.

These include handcrafted tea cakes made from High Mountain Oolong, tea-infused cookies, tea jelly, tea chocolates, tea-flavored pineapple cakes, tea candies, healthy green tea powder, crispy tea snacks, tea rice cakes (Chagell), and tea-roasted peanuts. Some gift sets even blend tea with local fruits and botanicals, preserving the tea's aroma while adding a touch of creativity and aesthetic elegance.

Whether shared with loved ones or savored slowly by yourself, these gifts serve as a perfect reminder of your unforgettable moments in the heart of tea country.

Things You Didn't Know About Tea

Why is Taiwanese tea world-famous?

A: Because Taiwan has three natural advantages that make exceptional tea possible

- ★ Misty mountains: Finer aroma
- ★ Large day-night temperature difference: Sweeter taste
- ★ World-class craftsmanship: Centuries of expertise passed down through generations

Are Green, Black, and Oolong Tea from Different Trees?

A: **Nope!** All three come from the exact same tea tree (Camellia sinensis). The difference lies entirely in the processing method (oxidation).

Green Tea	Oolong Tea	Black Tea
Almost non-oxidized	Partially oxidized	Fully oxidized

Pro Tip: If you have a sensitive stomach or are prone to stomachaches, Black Tea is your best friend. It's the gentlest and most soothing option!

High Mountain Tea? Just how high is "High"?

A: It refers to tea grown at an altitude of over 1,000 meters.

The mist and low temperatures of the high mountains make the tea sweeter and less bitter.

Examples: * Dayuling Tea: Grown above 2,200 meters, it is one of Taiwan's highest and most precious tea areas. Hua-gang (Lishan): Currently the highest tea region in Taiwan, reaching an elevation of 2,520 meters.

Why is Taiwan tea often named after mountains or places?

A: A tea's name is usually its "hometown."

Names like Alishan, Lishan, and Sun Link Sea represent more than just locations; the altitude, soil, and temperature swings of these places are hidden within the tea's aroma and taste.

For example: Alishan tea grows in misty mountains with large temperature gaps between day and night. The brew is bright with floral and subtle milky notes, making it exceptionally smooth.

Why is "Hand-Shaken Drink" culture so popular in Taiwan?

A: Hand-shaken drinks are an extension of the Taiwanese passion for tea and creativity.

From formal tea ceremonies to casual tea tables, and from teapots to to-go cups, tea is deeply rooted in daily life. "Pearl Milk Tea" (Boba) is a world-famous invention and the perfect symbol of how Taiwan blends tea tradition with modern creativity.

If I eat "Tea-infused Cuisine," will the leaves taste bitter?

A: **Not at all!** In cooking, tea is used as a flavor enhancer rather than just a vegetable.

Whether it's the smoky aroma of tea-smoked meats or the refreshing scent infused into soups, tea adds layers of freshness and sweetness. The most common example in Taiwan is the flavorful "Tea Egg" found in every convenience store.

Is "Oriental Beauty" picked by beautiful women?

A: **Nope!** The story behind the name is actually...

Legend has it that a British tea merchant presented this tea to the Queen a century ago. She was captivated by the colorful leaves and the honey-like aroma, so she bestowed upon it the name "Oriental Beauty."

This unique flavor is created by a tiny insect called the "Jacobiasca formosana" (small green leafhopper). When the insect bites the leaves, the plant produces a natural honey and fruity fragrance as a self-defense mechanism.

Is "Winter Melon Tea" a type of tea leaf?

A: **Winter Melon Tea is not made from tea leaves, and it contains zero tea!**

It's a sweet drink made by slow-cooking winter melon with sugar. Taiwanese people traditionally call many brewed infusions "Tea" (Chá). Similarly, "Longan and Red Date Tea" contains no tea leaves either.

In Taiwan, "Tea" sometimes represents a drinking culture rather than the plant itself.

Why does everyone say "drinking tea helps you lose weight"?

A: **Tea isn't a magic weight-loss pill, but its components offer great benefits:**

- ★ Caffeine: Boosts metabolism and increases calorie burning.
- ★ Tea Polyphenols (Catechins): Help break down fat and reduce absorption.
- ★ Amino Acid Balance: Increases satiety, helping you avoid sugary snacks.

Other Health Benefits:

- ★ Antioxidant properties to delay aging.
- ★ Aids digestion and cuts through greasiness after a heavy meal.
- ★ Refreshes the mind and maintains daily vitality.

Since Taiwan tea is so famous, can I buy it anywhere in the world?

A: **While exported globally, the finest high-mountain teas with limited production often stay in Taiwan.**

Harsh environments and limited yields make these delicate, high-quality teas rare and hard to replicate. This makes them a "must-buy" souvenir for travelers.

Beyond loose leaves, tea-infused treats like Tie Guan Yin Pineapple cakes and Alishan Tea Egg Rolls are also incredibly popular!

Since 2014, inspired by European wine estates, the Agriculture and Food Agency has guided tea farmers to transition from simple production to integrated tourism (6th Sector Industry).
